SHABBAT BA-BAYIT (SHABBAT IN THE HOME)

is a unique opportunity to come together around the Shabbat table and enjoy good food, family and friends. The vision is for the whole congregation to either host or be hosted at a fellow temple member's Shabbat dinner table.

SHABBAT DINNER DETAILS:

- All temple members are welcome to participate! Sign up to host in your home or to be hosted in a home.
- Sign up to participate and we will match you with other participants, or sign up together with other families.
- Every home will receive a Shabbat bag which will include Shabbat blessings and songs, candles, a word of Torah, discussion questions, kids' activities, and some treats.
- It will be a memorable Shabbat evening! This is a great way to get to know other temple families better.

The host family is responsible for: setting the start time, the main dish, and assigning participants what to bring.

Participants are responsible for: contributing to the dinner (host family will assign you a side dish, challah, drinks, dessert, etc.)

Each home should designate one participant to pick up your Shabbat bag at the temple on Friday.
